#### WE WILL FOCUS ON...

- Solidifying VBFS's position as the predominant toddler-8th grade independent school in Virginia Beach.
- Building a comprehensive program of instruction that gives the child an exceptional pathway for growth.
- Strengthening the overall academic program while continuing to expand experiential learning focusing on environmental sustainability, global competency, and opportunities for service to the community that will provide skills students will need to be successful in their lives after VBFS.
- Ensuring that the VBFS educational program embraces the understanding of the Quaker testimonies of Simplicity, Peace, Integrity, Community, Equality, and Stewardship, at all levels, along with awareness of self and others in a diverse and inclusive environment.
- Providing a continuous review of the academic program and expand professional development opportunities for our teachers.
- Fostering leadership growth and opportunities at the Board, Administration, and Faculty levels.
- Recruiting and retaining highly qualified professionals that meet VBFS standards.

#### WE WILL ACHIEVE PROGRESS BY ...

- Creating a regular process for curriculum review on a three-year cycle that looks at core and specialty subjects.
- Deepening student understanding of diversity, equity, inclusion, and social justice within a community of belonging through a multicultural curriculum.
- Furthering development of an academic curriculum that addresses that variety of learning styles at VBFS that ensures all students are academically challenged at their respective levels.
- Continuing to build experiential learning opportunities that foster qualities of resilience, flexibility, empathy-building, self-reflection, and perspective through with local mission-aligned community organizations.
- Providing a picture of what a student gains as a result of receiving a Quaker education and what a faculty member gains as a result of teaching the Quaker testimonies.
- Developing a faculty review process that recognizes how faculty incorporate the Quaker testimonies.
- Providing faculty and administration with consistent and relevant professional development opportunities.
- Providing more information and communication to current parents regarding day-to-day curriculum to present the value in a VBFS education.
- Benchmarking and analyzing student achievement at divisional levels through appropriate assessment.









#### WE WILL FOCUS ON...

- Developing a comprehensive facilities master plan to implement improvements, innovation, and modernization to the building and our exterior space to meet the specific needs of the school going forward.
- Developing a capital maintenance management plan to ensure timely updates and maintenance to existing spaces.
- Reinforcing the Quaker mission and advance our facilities and programs by developing a campus stewardship plan that involves the school as well as members of the wider community.
- Proactively maximizing land-use opportunities and addressing challenges that impact the school.

#### WE WILL ACHIEVE PROGRESS BY ...

- Assessing individual buildings with regard to mechanical, roofs, plumbing, etc. to create an Asset Management Plan.
- Developing realistic time frames and cost analyses for needed improvements to existing buildings and the construction of new buildings.
- Updating hazardous material reports for existing buildings.
- Opening dialogue between faculty and staff regarding the needs and wants for current and future facilities.
- Redeveloping stormwater management throughout the campus.
- Evaluating foot traffic to and from the VBFS campus from non-VBFS communities.
- Developing strategies to mitigate security risks.
- Implementing a campus-wide stewardship plan.
- Using facility and masterplan updates such as stormwater management improvements as stewardship teachable opportunities.
- Connecting the VBFS community with the Friends Meeting Buildings and Grounds Committee so that students can participate in Meeting clean-up events.









#### WE WILL FOCUS ON...

- Creating shared experiences that provide opportunities for community engagement.
- Fostering active participation by the various constituencies that intersect with the school community internally and externally.
- Creating relationships that help establish lifelong partnerships through shared values rooted in the Quaker testimonies.
- Increasing brand awareness of VBFS throughout the Hampton Roads community by marketing VBFS's unique selling proposition of valuesbased education.

#### WE WILL ACHIEVE PROGRESS BY ...

- Building connections and increase visibility from the board level to the parent level.
- Integrating families, students, staff, and community members deeply into school culture, programs, activities, volunteer opportunities, and events.
- Developing a robust alumni engagement and networking platform.
- Partnering with external organizations that are mission aligned to encourage community involvement and to support the development of academic, social, physical, creative, and emotional needs of students.
- Creating a robust extracurricular and athletic program that builds community.
- Fostering the growth of ancillary programs that reach the greater Hampton Roads community.
- Articulating the benefits of a values-based Quaker education vs. an independent school education.
- Positioning VBFS as the individual-focused attainable private-based education opportunity in Hampton Roads.
- Continuing weekly Meeting for Worship led by middle school students and regularly open Meeting for Worship to the wider community.
- Building on the existing Quakerism in Action curriculum and to foster a spirit of charitable fundraising and giving at the student level.
- Utilizing outside speakers to educate community members on Quakerism.

#### WE WILL FOCUS ON...

- Securing the school's short and long-term financial success.
- Ensuring enrollment objectives are met in order to meet maximum operational efficiency.
- Communicating and emphasize the importance of Annual Giving.
- Continuing exploration of grant funding opportunities.
- Completing a successful Capital Campaign to strengthen the school's value position among private schools in the Hampton Roads Market.
- Creating an endowment for long-term financial security.
- Prioritizing philanthropy to support the mission of the school and vision of the Strategic Plan.
- Developing a Financial Plan that incorporates all initiatives generated from the Strategic Plan to help achieve long-term financial security.
- Ensuring tuition and tuition assistance remain aligned with market trends and the school's mission.
- Safeguarding the ability to hire and keep wellqualified teachers in a competitive market.

#### WE WILL ACHIEVE PROGRESS BY...

- Developing and maintaining multi-year budget projections that align with enrollment and operational growth.
- Maintaining an actively engaged board led Budget and Finance Committee to help oversee long-term strategic growth.
- Developing a capital campaign plan outlining this transformational project and how impactful gifts will be over the five-year campaign period using subcommittees with targeted goals for reaching out to prospects to gain pledges.
- Creating a feasibility study survey in regards to the "Make New Friends" capital campaign which yields highly positive and supportive results.
- Creating donor pyramid models through Wealth Engine software for each of our immediate constituent bases that highlights an estimated giving capacity proving that donors have the financial means to contribute to a campaign.
- Setting a goal to obtain a \$1,000,000 endowment as part of the capital campaign.
- Reiterating the importance of securing an endowment fund that is in addition to working capital that will support expansion and improvements to current programs.
- Consulting with a financial expert on the best investment program for the endowment fund that balances risk with return.
- Using the endowment to support financial needs at the discretion of the Board of Trustees in response to external causes beyond the control of leadership.
- Emphasizing the importance of the Annual Fund to new and returning families prior to admission and the start of the school year.
- Educating the community on VBFS differentiators in our fundraising efforts in order to increase support.
- Refreshing annual fundraising events to increase participation within our community.
- Fostering the relationships with our immediate contact segments in order to increase their investment in VBFS.
